3 Further, Evidence Code section 453 provides that a Request for Judicial Notice of any  
4 matter specified in Evidence Code section 452 must be granted so long as a party requests judicial  
5 notice, presents the Court with sufficient information to support the request, and provides  
6 sufficient notice of the Request to each of its adversaries. Having satisfied each these judicial  
7 notice prerequisites here, petitioner respectfully requests that this Request for Judicial Notice be  
8 granted.
