Pursuant to Evidence Code sections 452 and 453, petitioner Vallejo Sun LLC respectfully requests that the Court take judicial notice of **Exhibit C** and **Exhibit D** to the Declaration of Aaron R. Field in Support of Motion for Judgment Granting Petition for Declaratory Relief and Writ of Mandate (“Field Decl.”).

The Court may take judicial notice of the official acts of the legislative, executive, and judicial departments of the United States and of any state of the United States. (Evid. Code § 452(c).) In particular, the Court may take judicial notice of legislative history where, as here, a case requires the Court to interpret a statute, including the Senate Judiciary Committee report and the Assembly Floor Analysis at issue here. (*Sac. Television Stations Inc. v. Superior Court* (2025) 111 Cal. App. 5th 984, 997 n.10 [“On our own motion, we take judicial notice of Assembly Bill

1 No. 748's legislative history.”] [citing Evid. Code §§ 452 (c), 459.); *Kaufman & Broad*  
2 *Communities v. Performance Plastering, Inc.* (“*Kaufman*”) (2005) 133 Cal.App.4th 26, 30.)

3 Further, Evidence Code section 453 provides that a Request for Judicial Notice of any  
4 matter specified in Evidence Code section 452 must be granted so long as a party requests judicial  
5 notice, presents the Court with sufficient information to support the request, and provides  
6 sufficient notice of the Request to each of its adversaries. Having satisfied each these judicial  
7 notice prerequisites here, petitioner respectfully requests that this Request for Judicial Notice be  
8 granted.
